Purpose and Scope:

A Gasoline Dispensing Facility (GDF) is a facility that has equipment to transfer fuel from a stationary storage tank to a fuel tank in a motorized vehicle. GDF's are regulated under state and federal environmental regulations.

GDF's are located at fuel docks throughout Morenci Operations.

Processing: Gasoline Tank G1, G2 and G3

Mine: Gasoline Tank 72, 73, 76, 78 and 79

Other GDFs may be installed in the future

Safety: Exposure to Hazardous Substances- Chronic

Responsible Parties:

All personnel	Ensure compliance with BMP and report any concerns to Supervisors and Environmental Services immediately.
Environmental Services and area owners	Conduct periodic inspections of the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Hoses & Fittings (including gas caps)• Nozzles & Hangers• Pumps & Compressors working properly• Catch pans• Secondary Containment (free of trash and debris)• Spills• Signage

Specialized Tools/Skills/Training: All personnel shall have access to this Best Management Practice.

Procedures:

- Minimize gasoline spills
- Clean up spills quickly as possible
- Cover all open gasoline containers and all gasoline storage tank fill-pipes with a gasketed seal cover when not in use
- Minimize gasoline sent to open waste collection systems that collect and transport gasoline to reclamation and recycling devices, such as oil/water separators.

Records: Environmental Services will maintain records of periodic GDF inspections.
