- Key to your Policy Success

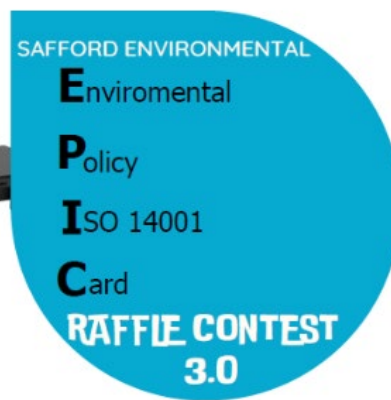
How does Safford Operation comply with the Corporate Policy?
