



# Potential Fatal Event: Employee Struck by Light Vehicle

## Preliminary Incident Details

<b>Operation</b>	El Abra
<b>Date / Time</b>	September 3, 2023 / 3:30 p.m.
<b>Type</b>	Injury
<b>Summary</b>	Two employees were working at night to install an aeration system. They parked their light duty truck in the piping area, which was beyond the designated parking zone. During the job, one of the employees got back in the truck and drove in reverse to leave, striking another employee who was behind the truck. Emergency protocol was activated. The injured employee sustained multiple fractures.
<b>Fatal Risk</b>	Vehicle Impact to Person
<b>Risk Category</b>	Monitor
<b>Pre / Post Rating</b>	Significant (3) Possible (2)
<b>Findings / Missing Controls</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Poor visibility due to glare from light plant on nearby facility</li><li>• No signage prohibiting parking beyond designated area</li><li>• Aftermarket engineering controls were not working properly (i.e., proximity sensor, backup alarm, backup camera)</li></ul>

<b>Employee Condition</b>	Recovering and in stable condition
