

WHAT IS E-WASTE?

Electronic Waste or E-Waste is described as discarded electrical or electronic devices. Used electronics which are destined for reuse, resale, salvage, recycling or disposal are also considered E-Waste. E-Waste consists of, but is not limited to: computers, monitors, laptops, tablets, radios, cell phones, printers, circuit boards, control instrumentation, etc.

GENERAL GUIDELINES

Morenci has developed procedures for recycling many materials in order to minimize waste disposal costs and to reduce the volume of waste sent to off-site landfills.

Improper management of Electronic Waste may result in the generation of hazardous waste.

All E-Waste should be delivered to the Environmental Yard for proper recycling. Electronic equipment with an asset number assigned to it **MUST** be routed through the MIS group before it is delivered to the Environmental Yard. If not sure the electronic equipment has an asset number contact MIS for information and further instructions.

EMPLOYEE TRAINING

All personnel shall receive training or at the least have access to this BMP when handling E-Waste on Morenci property.

Training will be provided by your Supervisor and/or Team Environmental Coordinator.
