

**WHAT DO I DO WITH USED OIL FILTERS?**

- All used oil filters should be drained until free-flowing oil ceases draining. If an oil filter press is available, it may be employed to squeeze additional oil from the filters before they are placed in the roll-off, but its use is not required.
- Any cart, apparatus, or collection system used to drain oil filters that contains the drained oil for any period of time must be labeled "Used Oil" (See **BMP No. 310 - Used Oil Management**).
- All used filters must be deposited in roll-off containers specially designated and labeled "Used Oil Filters and Used Oil", once drained, punctured and/or crushed.
- Only used oil filters should be placed in the designated roll-off container. In no case should other filters (fuel, coolant, etc.), trash, dirt, or other debris be placed in roll-off container containing used oil filters.
- When the used oil filter containers are full, contact Environmental Services to arrange for shipment.
