

ENVIRONMENTAL BEST MANAGEMENT PRACTICE BMP No. 316 Used Absorbents and Used Rags

DEFINITIONS

Non-Hazardous Used Absorbent

Non-hazardous used absorbent is absorbent that is used to absorb and clean up petroleum products, latex paint and other non-hazardous products, which usually do not exhibit a hazardous waste characteristic.

Non-Hazardous Used Rags

Non-hazardous used rags (i.e. paper, rag-on-a-roll, cloth) are rags that are used to absorb and clean up petroleum products, latex paint and other non-hazardous products which usually do not exhibit a hazardous waste characteristic.

Hazardous Used Absorbent

Hazardous used absorbent is absorbent used to absorb and clean up hazardous products, (i.e. solvents, non-latex paint, acid, etc.) which exhibit a hazardous waste characteristic or contain a listed hazardous waste.

Hazardous Used Rags

Hazardous used rags are rags that are used to absorb and clean up hazardous products, (i.e. solvents, non-latex paint, acid, etc.) which exhibit a hazardous waste characteristic or contain a listed hazardous waste.

WHAT REQUIREMENTS MUST BE FOLLOWED IF THE USED RAGS OR ABSORBENTS ARE HAZARDOUS WASTE?

- A hazardous waste accumulation container must be a DOT approved 1A2 open head drum.
 (Available from Environmental Services.)
- If generating both hazardous rags and hazardous absorbent, they must be collected in separate containers.
- A container for hazardous used absorbent must be clearly labeled with the words "Hazardous Waste" and "Used Absorbent".
- A container for hazardous used rags must be clearly labeled with the words "Hazardous Waste" and "Used Rags".
- The container must be closed and sealed at all times except when adding or removing wastes.
 Putting a lid on the container without the clamp is not closed, as material will spill from the container if it were to fall.
- Drums must be handled and stored as per Environmental BMP No.313 Drum & Container Management.
- Container(s) must be stored in a Satellite Accumulation Area that is clearly marked and designated as a Satellite Accumulation Area as per Environmental BMP No. 328 – Satellite Accumulation Areas.
- Full containers must be transported to the Central Hazardous Waste Accumulation Facility located in the Environmental Yard within (3) three days from the date filled. Environmental

personnel must be available to receive the drum and check it into the Hazardous Waste Central Accumulation Point.

WHAT REQUIREMENTS MUST BE FOLLOWED IF THE SHOP'S USED RAGS OR ABSORBENT ARE NOT HAZARDOUS WASTE?

Used absorbents and used rags can only be thrown in the trash under direct guidance from Environmental Services

Non-hazardous used rags and absorbents that do not contain free flowing liquids must be periodically characterized by Environmental Services to determine if they can be disposed in the normal trash.

WHAT IF I AM UNCERTAIN IF USED ABSORBENT AND/OR USED RAGS ARE HAZARDOUS?

Contact Environmental Services for the waste determination.

EMPLOYEE TRAINING

All personnel shall receive training on this BMP when dealing with used absorbent and/or used rags on Morenci property.

Training will be provided by Supervisors and/or Team Environmental Representative.

All personnel who handle, store and manage hazardous waste used absorbent and/or hazardous waste used rags shall receive hazardous waste management training by the Environmental Services Department annually.
