

**WHAT IS CONTAMINATED SOIL?**

Contaminated soil (CS) is any soil, which has become contaminated with a material such as, paint, acid, petroleum products, etc. However soil which has become contaminated with petroleum products is commonly referred to as “petroleum contaminated soil (PCS)”.

**WHAT DO I DO WITH CONTAMINATED SOILS?**

- No contaminated soil is to be disturbed prior to contacting Environmental Services. Environmental Services will characterize and/or direct soil handling prior to soil disturbance.
- Contact of Environmental Services pursuant to the procedures is outlined in **BMP 400 – Spill Notification**.
- No soil shall be placed in dumpsters for disposal at the county landfill.
- Contaminated soils should be cleaned up in accordance with **BMP 402 – Spill Cleanup**.
- Contaminated soil should be placed in an appropriate container for the size of the project. For assistance, please contact anyone of the individuals extension or cell phones listed below in the Contact Section
- Containers shall not be opened, handled, or stored in a manner that may rupture the container or cause it to leak.

**WHAT DO I DO WITH CONTAMINATED SOILS (CS) or PETROLEUM CONTAMINATED SOILS (PCS)?**

- No CS or PCS shall be stored in piles except in the designated area at the Environmental Yard, PCS area, or under the direction of Environmental Services.
- Environmental Services shall be contacted before petroleum-contaminated soil is deposited at the Environmental Yard or PCS staging area.
- Containers used to transport CS or PCS to the Environmental Yard shall be kept closed except to add or remove CS or PCS. Drums shall be labeled and managed according to **BMP 313 – Drum/Container Management**.

**EMPLOYEE TRAINING**

All personnel shall receive training when dealing with contaminated soils on Morenci property. This training should be provided by the Supervisor and/or Team Environmental Coordinator.
