

WHAT IS A USED BATTERY?

A used battery (i.e. cell phone, laptop, rechargeable tools, lead acid, etc) is any type of battery that is no longer usable for its intended purpose.

WHAT DO I DO WITH USED NICKEL-CADMIUM, NICKEL-METAL HYDRIDE, ALKALINE, AND LITHIUM-ION BATTERIES?

- All used batteries must be collected they cannot be deposited into the trash.
- Obtain a collection container from Environmental Services.
- Collect all used batteries and deposit in an appropriate container labeled as follows:

Environmental Services will label and date the drum.

- The collection container will be labeled with the words "Universal Waste" and "Used Batteries"
- Call Environmental Services for any of the following:
 - 1. If batteries are too large for the container opening
 - 2. If anything other than batteries is inadvertently placed into the drum
 - 3. If drum is unlabeled or needs relabeled.
 - 4. If not dated or the date exceeds a year
- Notify Environmental Services for any issues relating to collection containers at 865-6000.
- Do not remove or relocate collection containers without first notifying Environmental Services.

ENVIRONMENTAL BEST MANAGEMENT PRACTICE BMP No. 326 Used Battery Management

All used lead acid batteries that are not accepted at the on-site automotive/equipment suppliers must be transported to the Environmental Yard for recyclability or waste determination.

Because Morenci handles lead acid batteries as Universal Waste a "Universal Waste – Batteries" label along with a date must appear on each container or each battery if collected outside a container (i.e. on pallets). Used lead acid battery containers must be kept closed. If using a method other than containers (i.e. pallets) that method must be covered during transport to the Environmental yard.

All New and Used Batteries must be stored in an enclosed area away from the elements on pallets or skids.

EMPLOYEE TRAINING

All personnel shall receive training or at the least have access to this BMP when dealing with used battery wastes on Morenci property, provided by Supervisor and/or Team Environmental Representative.

All employees handling and managing any universal wastes must receive annual Universal Waste Management Training provide by one of the Environmental Services Department personnel. Contact Environmental for scheduling.
