Morenci Painting Activities



Non-Aerosol Can Spray Painting Activities (BMP 100)



YES - this is policy

- Using at least one control method at all times
 (i.e. high pressure low volume spray guns)
- A record of all spray painting projects
- All paint jobs, except for spot painting and architectural coating, must be performed inside an enclosed paint booth/area
- Overspraying must be minimized
- Outdoor spot painting is allowable; however, you must follow proper procedures
- See BMP100 for special requirements when painting Haul Trucks, Shovels & Drill Rigs



NO – this is not allowed

- NO thinning or diluting architectural or spot painting coating
- NO testing a spray gun toward the dirt
- NO using photochemically reactive solvents outdoors
- **NO** Exceeding 20% opacity
- NO using products <u>not</u> pre-approved by Env. Services and Industrial Hygiene
- **NO** spray painting without protecting the **ground surface**

Latex/Water-Based Waste Paint Management (BMP 337)



- **Store** paint in a flammable storage cabinet marked "Flammable"
- Use only approved paint products
- Do <u>NOT</u> place paint or paint cans into the <u>trash</u>
- Deliver all excess paint (not being stored for future use) to the Environmental Yard
- Never leave a paint can open for extended periods of time

Hazardous Waste Paint (BMP 303)

Hazardous Waste Paint <u>may be stored</u> in a Satellite Accumulation Area if the following is met:

- Store waste paint (i.e. oil based) in a DOT approved 1A1 closed head drum with correct labeling and within a designated satellite accumulation area
- Immediately **date** the drum once it becomes full and move it to the Enviro Yard within **three (3)** days of becoming full
- Do not store more than **55 gallons** of waste paint at a single satellite accumulation area
- The individual performing the painting is responsible for all record keeping requirements as well as properly managing all related wastes



<u>OR</u>

If there is no Satellite Accumulation Area or you do not choose to manage Hazardous Waste Paint in your area, deliver all waste to the Enviro Yard as you finish with the product (including brushes, rollers, trays, drop cloths, etc)

Remember: Hazardous waste paint cannot be combined with any other waste.
