

# *Environmental Share* SPCC – Spill Prevention Control & Countermeasure Plan



## What is SPCC Plan?

Written plan develop for facilities that store, use or consume oil to prevent oil/petroleum product spills from reaching navigable waters and to comply with EPA's Oil Spill Prevention Program.

## What to know about the SPCC Plan...

- Plan covers all tanks and/or containers of 55 gallons or more that contain oil or petroleum products such as diesel fuel, gasoline, organics, hydraulic oil, greases, motor oil, etc
- Tanks and/containers must be good condition – report any damage or leaks to your supervisor
- Secondary containment is required on all tanks and/or containers – types of secondary containment: concrete, metal, plastic, earthen berm

## What you can do.....

- Submit an MOC and notify Environmental Services when:
  - Installing new tank/container
  - Moving existing tank/container
- Secondary containment must be free of liquids and debris – contact your supervisor if you find a containment that has liquids present
- Draining liquids to the ground from a secondary containment is **NOT** allowed!
- Place drip pans or buckets under connections when filling or dispensing from tanks/containers to catch spills that may occur
