Morenci Equipment Storage

Storage Guidelines (BMP 332)



*If storing for a **short duration**, a visual inspection must be made on a **WEEKLY** basis*

*If storing for **over a month at a time**, all fluids must be drained and a visual inspection must be conducted on a **MONTHLY** basis.*



*Long-term storage inspections must be recorded on the **EQUIPMENT STORAGE TAGS** attached to the equipment. ***



*** If equipment is stored in secured fenced area, one tag can be placed on the gate to cover all equipment inside the fence.*

Additional Information

- All Equipment being stored is required to be up off the ground on pallets, concrete or asphalt to help facilitate inspection and observation of leaks of the equipment. Equipment that has wheels or tracks is considered up off the ground.
- All equipment stored **indoors on concrete or similar impervious material** is EXEMPT from the monthly tagging requirements however if fluid leaks occur apply spill clean-up methods.
- All unnecessary fluids will be drained before the equipment is stored. Fluids that are **required** to retain the integrity of the equipment are permissible.
- Tags are available from Hagemeyer's Safety Supply located at the Global Sourcing building on the Processing side.
- If any leaks are noted during the inspection, action must be taken to stop or contain the leak. This may include repair, drip pans, and/or draining the fluid.
