


ENVIRONMENTAL MONTHLY SHARE

Morenci “Scrap” Materials

Don't forget - the job isn't finished until the worksite is cleared of all scrap materials


Scrap Conveyor Belting (BMP 339)

	<h3>Sort</h3> <p>Segregate steel-belted from non-steel belted prior to delivery</p>	<h3>Transport</h3> <table border="0"> <tr> <td>Reusing it? ↓ Transport back to your shop</td> <td>Recycling it? ↓ Transport it to Enviro Salvage Yard for recycling</td> </tr> </table>	Reusing it? ↓ Transport back to your shop	Recycling it? ↓ Transport it to Enviro Salvage Yard for recycling	<h3>Store</h3> <p>Stack scrap belting neatly or place in a designated bin</p> <p>**Do not store scrap belting with trash, scrap wood, etc</p>
Reusing it? ↓ Transport back to your shop	Recycling it? ↓ Transport it to Enviro Salvage Yard for recycling				

****Remember** - Scrap conveyor belting can not be thrown into the trash



HDPE/LDPE Recycling (BMP 338)

	<h3>Sort</h3> <p>Segregate HDPE from LDPE prior to delivery</p>	<h3>Transport</h3> <table border="0"> <tr> <td>Reusing it? ↓ Transport back to your laydown yard</td> <td>Recycling it? ↓ Transport it to the Plastic Recycling Facility</td> </tr> </table>	Reusing it? ↓ Transport back to your laydown yard	Recycling it? ↓ Transport it to the Plastic Recycling Facility	<h3>Store</h3> <p><i>At the recycling facility</i>, store in individual staging areas.</p> <p><i>In laydown yards</i>, stack neatly or place into designated bins (must be sorted!)</p>
Reusing it? ↓ Transport back to your laydown yard	Recycling it? ↓ Transport it to the Plastic Recycling Facility				



****Remember** Scrap plastic shavings must be collected and either:

1. Transported to the recycling facility; or
2. Transported back to your shop for temporary storage prior to transporting to the recycling facility

Used Power Poles & Railroad Ties (BMP 335)

	<h3>Sort</h3> <p><i>All pieces</i> must either be reused or taken to the Enviro Salvage Yard</p>	<h3>Transport</h3> <table border="0"> <tr> <td>Reusing it? ↓ Transport back to your laydown yard</td> <td>Unusable? ↓ Transport poles and ties to Enviro Salvage Yard (designated areas)</td> </tr> </table>	Reusing it? ↓ Transport back to your laydown yard	Unusable? ↓ Transport poles and ties to Enviro Salvage Yard (designated areas)	<h3>Store</h3> <p><i>Used ties:</i> stored on pallets <i>Used poles:</i> stored in pole racks</p> <p>In laydown yards, keep used ties and poles stacked neatly when not in use</p>
Reusing it? ↓ Transport back to your laydown yard	Unusable? ↓ Transport poles and ties to Enviro Salvage Yard (designated areas)				

****Did You Know?** – The black gummy substance you see on RR ties and utility poles is creosote - a commonly used wood preservative
