Spill Notification: How to Report



What is a Spill?

A spill is the loss of product or waste, solid, liquid or gas that is release outside normal operations. Spills can occur anywhere, including secondary containment, stockpiles, road ditches, etc.

What to know about Spill Notification...

- Spills are typically coordinated by the individual department unless Environmental Services advises you otherwise.
- Always ask for help if unsure about how to proceed – contact the Enviro Service On-call person or call the Spill Hotline.

What you can do.....

- Contact supervisor and/or the Command Center so they can report the spill if you are unable to do so.
- Notify the Spill Hotline at 928-865-SPIIL (7745)
- Clean up the spill if it is safe to do so or involve the company designated to clean up spills if you need assistance:
 - Burk's Sanitation for the Mine
 - Surface Department for the Processing side
- Contact the Environmental Yard at 928-865-7391 for guidance on how to dispose of the cleaned up waste if you are unsure.
