Waste Water Treatment Plant

- Morenci commissioned a brand new Wastewater treatment Plant (WWTP) in August of 2017.
- The WWTP treats the wastewater from the Morenci Town, Morenci Mine, Processing Site and the town of Clifton.



- The plant has a very sophisticated operation.
- The WWTP is a "living" machine that uses organisms (bugs) to clean the wastewater. So... how can you help to ensure the organisms will continue to clean the wastewater?
 - If a spill reached the sewer system please report it immediately to the Environmental Services. Acid, oil, metals and other chemicals can kill the organisms in the WWTP.

How Can You Help at Home?

- Towels/wet wipes, etc have many uses at home
- Please <u>DO NOT</u> flush paper towels/wet wipes, etc down the toilet or throw into the porta-johns. They clog the sewer systems, increase maintenance costs: replacing motors, unplugging sewer lines/septic tanks, etc.
- Please throw all paper towels/wet wipes, etc into a trash can.
- Paper towels/wet wipes, etc <u>do not</u> break down in water
- Toilet paper is designed to degrade in water
