

# Satellite Accumulation Area

## ➤ What is a Satellite Accumulation Area (SAA)?

- Designated containers for generators to accumulate small amounts of hazardous waste

## ➤ What is a Hazardous Waste?

- A waste that is Toxic, Reactive, Ignitable, Corrosive “TRIC”
- Defined as “Hazardous Waste” under Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA)

## ➤ Requirements for SAA per EPA regulations:

- Must not exceed 55 gallons of one type of hazardous waste in a working area
- Proper labeling containing “Hazardous Waste”
- Only one container per waste may be in the working area
- Container must be closed unless adding or removing waste
- Must be at or near the point of generation
- Only one waste stream per container
- Under control of the operator
