

Introduction

Management - ISO 14001

Environmental Management System International Standards specifies requirements to enable an organization to develop & implement an Environmental Management System.

Management program is <u>designed</u> to include all legal requirements, permits, policies, and industry practices.

Defines roles and responsibilities.

Continuous improvement is an important part of the program and includes audits and other measurements.

ISO 14001 is a mandatory program for <u>all</u> Freeport McMoRan facilities.

Chemical Inventory & SDS

<u>All</u> chemicals in use on the property must be approved by <u>both</u> the Health & Safety Department and the Environmental Services Department prior to the chemicals being purchased or brought on the property.

<u>Sphera Database</u> contains all reviewed products that have been approved or disapproved for use & copies of their SDS'.

Morenci Spill Notification

A spill is <u>any</u> event, outside of normal operations, which results in a loss of product or waste material.

Environmental Services Department <u>must be notified of all spills</u>.


Air Quality



Permit: Legally-enforceable documents designed to improve compliance by clarifying what facilities (sources) must do to control air pollution

Permits:

- Title V (Morenci Mine/Processing)
- Two Class II (Upper Eagle Creek)
- Three Open Burn (Mine/ Morenci Townsite/Clifton Townsite)





Regulations:

- Metallic Mineral Processing
- Nonmetallic Mineral Processing
- Multiple Engine
- Gasoline dispensing
- Accidental Chemical Release

Air Quality Management

Areas of Concern:

- Dust Emissions (including Blasting)
- Spray Painting Activities
- Generators/Engines Environmental Services must be notified of any new or removal of generators/engines
- Asbestos Renovation/Demolition
- Process Changes -Physical/Operational Modifications






Air Quality Management

- Refrigerant handling documentation, certification, recovery, & disposal
- Ozone Protection When a release of chlorofluorocarbon (CFC) occurs, the sun breaks down the CFC's in the atmosphere and the breakdown of products destroy Ozone
- Monitoring and Recordkeeping
- No Open Burning









Waste Handling Regulations

Waste is defined by specific characteristics that determine it being classified as a particular type of waste. Waste types are regulated and have specified storage and handling requirements.

- Hazardous Waste
- Universal Waste
- Solid Waste
- Special Waste





Types of Wastes

Hazardous Waste - Placed in Satellite Accumulation Drums

- Aerosol cans
- Solvent rags
- Gasoline filters
- Lab wastes
- Broken light bulbs
- Paint related debris

Universal Wastes – Placed in Universal Waste drums

- Light bulbs
- Batteries

Municipal Solid Wastes – Placed in trash cans or roll-offs

- Lunch room trash
- Cardboard (recyclable)
- Wood

Industrial Wastes

- Electronics Taken to the Environmental Yard
- Petroleum contaminated debris Use gray PC Debris drums
- Tires Taken to the Environmental Yard

Waste Handling Guidelines



You <u>may never</u> dispose of Hazardous Wastes by

- placing them in the garbage
- letting them evaporate into the atmosphere or
- dumping them down the drain and/or into a sewer system.





Water Quality Regulations

CWA - Clean Water Act

Requires a permit for the discharge of a pollutant into Waters of the US from any point source.

MSGP – Multisector General Permit EPA permit that covers storm water discharges.

AZPDES – Arizona Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Responsibility to administer the Stormwater program for the EPA







Morenci is a "Zero Discharge" Facility

<u>All</u> stormwater that comes in contact with process activities is <u>contained</u> and is <u>not discharged</u> from the property. It is reused.

What: Applies to all petroleum based products Why:

- Because Morenci stores a high volume of petroleum products on site (greater than 1,320 gallons)
- To protect "Waters of the U.S." (rivers, washes, streams) from petroleum discharges

How:

- Outlines requirements for prevention of, preparedness for, and response to petroleum discharges
- The plan must detail in writing, the equipment, workforce, and steps required to prevent, control and mitigate an oil discharge.

Migratory Bird Conservation



Avian Handling and Reporting

If a bird of any type is encountered on the Morenci property, <u>do not handle, disturb, or collect the bird</u>.

Immediately report all bird mortalities, injuries, illnesses and sightings to the Environmental Services Department.

Positive verbal notification must be made to a staff member of the Environmental Services Department.



Wildlife Policy includes <u>all wildlife</u> found on Morenci property. Report all lingering, injured or deceased wildlife to Environmental Services.
