Wildlife Protection May 2017

- Wildlife is a valuable yet vulnerable resource. Freeport-McMoRan Safford, Inc. (FMSI) recognizes the obligation to protect wildlife.
- Accordingly, FMSI has implemented a Wildlife Management Plan with the principle aim of protecting wildlife and compliance with numerous federal and state regulatory acts and programs such as the Endangered Species Act, Migratory Bird Treaty Act, as well as other biodiversity and wildlife Protection measures.



What You Can DO

- Use the Management of Change Process (MOC). The MOC process gives the Environmental Services Department opportunity to consider changes to the mine and process effects on wildlife.
- Implement and comply with wildlife protection measures outlined in BMP 601. BMP 601 outlines protections for wildlife, including but not limited to:
 - Power lines, process ponds, tanks, leach stockpiles, process buildings/infrastructure, stored equipment, protection for nesting birds, protection for terrestrial wildlife and big game.
 - If you encounter injured or deceased animals, please do not handle. Contact Environmental Services.
